

## CareerEdge Profiled in National Report

The International Economic Development council recently released a report about the changing landscape of workforce "learning systems." CareerEdge is 1 of 5 national workforce development organizations profiled in the document, titled *Chutes & Ladders: The New Rules of the Game for Upskilling Workers.* According to the report, CareerEdge's success has been attributable in part to relationships with regional economic development organizations. #### Local Wages on the Rise

At CareerEdge's recent *Jobs, Jobs, Jobs* event, U.C. professor Dr. Chris Benner reported that overall average payrolls across all sectors have been rising since 2012, saying this was a 'good sign' for our local economy. In addition, the Sarasota-Manatee region added 5,200 jobs for the 12-month period ending in August, the ninth best rate of job growth in the state's 22 metro areas, according to Dr. Jerry Parrish, Chief Economist for the Florida Chamber of Commerce Foundation who also presented at the event. Manufacturing was the fastest growth sector, with Construction, Technical and Professional Services, Healthcare, and Transportation Services also experiencing solid growth.
